

FOCUS' Sanitizing & Safety Guidelines



We have been working tirelessly in researching, planning, and implementing the safest and healthiest protocols possible for our clients, dancers and employees once we are allowed to be in our building offering a hybrid of both Virtual and in-person classes.

- At home, self-screening will be required for all clients, dancers, and employees prior to coming to FOCUS. For guidance on how to self-screen for symptoms please visit the CDC website here:

- Dancers please arrive 10 to 15 minutes before class begins, and line up single file outside of FOCUS on the social distancing markers to the right of our entrance.
- FOCUS's hospitality team will take your temperature with touchless thermometers and supply hand sanitizer to everyone before entering the building. If your temperature is 100 or higher, we will not be able to allow you into FOCUS.
- **All Clients, Dancers, and Employees** will need to wear a mask until such time that the City of Irvine relaxes these protocols and FOCUS feels confident with their decision.

- FOCUS will be following the recommended social distancing protocols and looking at the size of each class to provide enough space for social distancing while dancing.
- Vinyl 6 ft distanced markers will be on the dance floors in all studios.
- Classes will begin 5 minutes into the class time and conclude 5 minutes before the end of class, to allow time for dancers to be safely escorted, in a single file line, in and out of the front entrance.
- ONLY dancers and employees will be allowed down the hallway and into the dance studios.
- Study Area will be temporarily closed to all.
- A limited number of people will be allowed in the lobby.
- Cleaning and disinfecting protocols will be strictly followed every day by our Cleaning Company.
- Hospitality Team will sanitize all surfaces throughout the building each hour, and disinfecting dance studio surfaces and floors will take place after each class.
- All areas of the building including dance studios will have disinfecting supplies, hand sanitizers, and tissue available to everyone as always.
- Water fountains will temporarily be unavailable for use.
- Please bring water bottles, or you may purchase bottled water from the vending machines.
- Disinfecting Shoe trays will be at the threshold of each studio for the dancers to clean the bottom of their dance shoes before taking a class.
